


Alabaster Offering

While we do not have fixed times when churches receive Alabaster offerings, many Nazarene churches across the globe will be receiving an Alabaster offering during the month of September. There will be coins, notes, electronic giving, and QR codes—all pointing to one purpose: laying foundations where people worship, heal, and learn.

On Saturday, June 29th, 2024, many Nazarenes joined in celebrating the 101st Anniversary of the IBN-Instituto Biblico Nazarneno (Nazarene Biblical Institute) in Coban, Guatemala, and its new status as a Nazarene historic site. The occasion also marked the 75th Anniversary of the completion of the building using Alabaster funds. This was the denomination's first Alabaster project.







At the June 2023 General Assembly, Coban IBN was approved as a historic site, so a special plaque was unveiled by the general superintendent Dr. Gustavo Crocker, a native son of Guatemala, to commemorate this wonderful occasion. Many local, district, regional, and global church leaders were present, including Rev. Jim Ritchie, Global Missions director. He said:

"I have always loved the vision and heart behind Alabaster, and as a Regional Director and now Global Missions Director, it has been so moving and exciting to see the end results of the church's sacrificial and joyful giving to Alabaster become a physical reality. I would encourage all Nazarene churches everywhere to play their part in Alabaster giving, as it really makes a difference. I also want to thank all local pastors and NMI leaders for keeping Alabaster at the forefront of the church's hearts and minds as they give their own gift to Jesus as he builds his church in this wonderful and unique way."
